

Introducing Mexico

A riot of colours, flavours and music, Mexico is a vast and varied country which has much more to offer than the stereotypes of tequila, tacos and sombreros. From the glittering waters of the Pacific coast and the wildlife rich Sea of Cortez to the white powdery sands of the Caribbean coast, there's a wealth of choice for a beach break. Inland you'll find vibrant colonial towns, ornate architecture, towering volcanoes, rugged canyons, cactus-strewn desert and the exciting metropolis of Mexico City.

As well as a rich and diverse cuisine, you'll also find a thriving art scene and impressive Mayan and Aztec archaeological sites. However, it's the people that will likely make your stay in Mexico unforgettable. Friendly, welcoming and decidedly proud of their country, Mexicans will charm you with their honest and open nature and will be sure to teach you a thing or two about Mexico beyond the stereotypes.

How to Get to Mexico

Although you can drive across the border from the US, Guatemala or Belize, most will fly here.

There are regular direct flights from major US cities (1.5-2.5 hours) and across Europe (around 12 hours). You'll likely arrive in Mexico City, although Cancun, Puerto Vallarta and Guadalajara are major international hubs, too.

To get around, hop between domestic airports then private transfer, self-drive, or long-distance buses are excellent and offer you a chance to admire the scenery.

When & Weather – Mexico

Mexico is generally sunny and the climate varies between Pacific and Caribbean coasts, as well as tropical lowlands and mountainous highlands.

Peak Season is the most popular time to visit (December – April). However the shoulder months of October and November are also a good time to visit certain areas.

Rainy season lasts from May to early October, but it tends to be short bursts of rain, in the afternoon. It can get very hot and humid from June to August.

Temperatures are varied and range between 6°C (42.8 °F) and 26°C (78 °F).

Who will Mexico Appeal To?

The idyllic landscapes and fascinating history and modern-day influences offer an enormous range of varied and unique experiences. In particular, it's suited to: Honeymooners - Beach and Culture lovers - Active travellers - Solo travellers - Families with children of all ages.

Accommodation

We work with boutique hotels in the cities, colonial casas in the smaller towns, luxury hideaways, rustic beach cabanas, glamping and everything in between.

Off The Beaten Path

Swim in the secret cenotes of the northern Yucatan - magical sunlit limestone caves with spring-water pools. Ek Balam, X'keken and Samula are our favourites. Bypass over-touristy Chichen Itza and head to lesser-visited Uxmal or south to Palenque, where you can explore atmospheric Mayan ruins enveloped in jungle. Puerto Escondido is charming – a laid-back little town with rustic seafood *palapas* and world-class surfing.

Wildlife

Watch humpback whales breach from Puerto Vallarta (Jan and Feb). Or watch the annual grey whale migration in the Baja lagoons.

From November to March, walk amongst thousands and thousands of monarch butterflies during the annual migration in Michoacan.

The wild and untouched areas of the Pacific Coast are host to astonishing biodiversity: manta rays, turtles, whales, iguanas and a huge array of bird species.

Eating tacos at local taquerias in Oaxaca – try the pibil (slow-roasted pork).


