Introducing Brazil

Covering an area the size of the USA, it's not surprising that Brazil has something to offer every kind of traveller. Beyond the glitz and glamour of its main cities, a raw and unrelenting energy shows a Brazil that is proud of its cultural heritage, whether Afro-Brazilian, carioca or tribal. When it comes to music and culture, there is more to Brazil than carnival celebrations and sizzling samba beats - soak in the soothing sounds of forro and lose yourself in addictive percussion in Bahia's state capital, Salvador.

From the depths of the Amazon Rainforest to the sweeping sand dunes of the northeast and glittering waters of the Emerald Coast, a land of staggering natural beauty and biodiversity awaits. Spot jaguars roaming the Pantanal wetlands and observe tropical birds soaring through treetops in the Atlantic rainforest, watch as masses of water plummets down the river at Iguassu Falls and hike through table top mountains in the valleys of Chapada Diamantina. And when talking about nature, it would be rude not to mention Brazil's beaches. Along the coast you'll find a beach for every day of the year, ranging from lively Copacabana to the pristine protected sands of Fernando de Noronha and beyond.

How to Get to Brazil

There are 500+ airports in Brazil. Unless you come overland, you'll likely fly into Rio, Sao Paolo, Salvador or Foz do Iguaçu.

There are direct flights from the UK, but many go via Europe or US. Direct flights from the UK take approx. 12 hours; from the US they range from 9-12 hours.

Once here, zip about between domestic hubs by plane (all cities have airports and all towns have at least an airstrip), or travel by luxury coach (*leitos*), but be warned, distances are enormous.

When & Weather - Brazil

The weather is diverse, as there are 5 climatic regions: equatorial, tropical, semiarid, highland tropical and subtropical. In general, the north is warm and humid; the south dryer, with an average daytime temperature of 25°C across the country. The so-called 'Rainy Season' is November to May and 'Dry Season' June to October, but it's really a year-round destination and you're likely to experience all weathers over a 2-week period. Daytime temperatures range between °18C (°65F) and °32C (°86F).

Off The Beaten Path

Admire the modernist architecture in UNESCO-listed Brasilia Jericoacoara's virgin beaches are world-class in their beauty.

Wildlife

Listen for howler monkeys and spot rare golden lion tamarins and bald uakari in the Amazon.



Take a boat trip past the Devil's Throat, the largest of the Iguazu Falls.




