Introducing Honduras

Jungle clad mountains home to incredible biodiversity, rich indigenous culture and the white sandy Bay Islands make for a wonderfully off the beaten path experience in little-visited Honduras, often overlooked by visitors to Central America. Give Honduras a chance and you'll be rewarded by the impressive Mayan ruins of Copan, charming mountain villages with natural hot springs and access to the world's second largest barrier reef. Travelling through Honduras will be an adventure and a chance to stay away from the tourist trail. There is huge appeal for those curious enough to venture here.

How to Get to Honduras

You can travel overland from neighbouring Guatemala, El Salvador and Nicaragua. If you're flying here, you'll likely arrive in San Pedro Sula, Tegucigalpa or into Roatan Island.

Flight time from the UK is approx. 11 hours; from the USA 3-8 hours. Once here, you can hop about by air (inexpensive and frequent), but most travel by road. There are 'executive' coaches plying the main routes. Explore La Moskitia, Roatan, Isla El Tigre and Las Marías via water taxis, ferries and motorised canoes.

When & Weather – Honduras

The climate is hot and humid for most of the year. The Dry Season runs from November to April and the wet season from May to October, though the Caribbean Coast also experiences heavy rain from September to February. Hurricane season runs from June to November. Temperatures range between 14°C (26°F) and 25°C (32°F).

Who will Honduras Appeal To?

Adventure lovers. Travelling here is still often off the beaten track, with limited tourist infrastructure. In particular, it's suited to:
Active travellers - Tourist-trail avoiders - Solo travellers - Wildlife & birding enthusiasts - Diving & Water-sport enthusiasts.

Accommodation

Honduras offers a range of character hotels, beach resorts, ecolodges, beach cabanas and simple homestays in remote villages.

Off The Beaten Path

Explore the Río Plátano Biosphere Reserve by *pipante* canoe, passing remote jungle villages and hidden Mayan ruins.

Go white water rafting over Class III and IV rapids in the Pico Bonito National Park. La Ruta Lenca is a trail of remote villages along the ascent of El Cerro de las Minas, Honduras's highest mountains. As you climb you'll see Lenca women in traditional coloured headdresses working the fields.

Island hop around the Cayos Cochinos, an archipelago of perfect white-sand cays.

Wildlife

There's fantastic birdwatching on the Lago de Yojoa, a microclimate with over 400 different species, including herons, kingfishers and hawks.

Utila is known as the whale shark capital of the Caribbean.

Endangered giant leatherback turtles nest at Plaplaya between April and June.

Jeanette Kawas National Park is home to thousands of noisy howler monkeys.

Keep your eyes peeled for colourful quetzal when hiking through cloud forest.

Honduras Experiences you shouldn't miss

The magnificent Mayan ruins at Copan including an amazing hieroglyphic stairway.

Hiking through pristine tropical forest in Pico Bonito National Park.

World-famous snorkelling and diving in the Islas de la Bahía.

Giving back

The La Ceiba-based Adelante Foundation is doing its part to eliminate poverty by providing "micro-credit" loans to extremely poor women in rural Honduras who never before had access to money. The women use the money to start their own micro-businesses. Eventually as the businesses grow, their loan payments increase and over time many can work their way out of poverty. Travel into the backcountry of Honduras with English speaking Adelante staff and attend an "Assembly" which is where potential borrowers meet to learn new business skills and important health or nutrition information. Listen to the challenges faced by these women and support them in their micro-business endeavours. A portion of the proceeds will go to the Adelante Foundation which is a U.S. registered non profit foundation.
