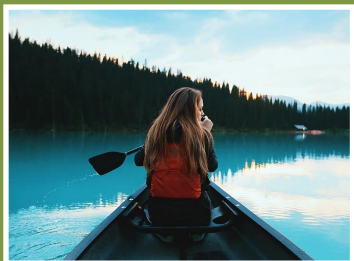

Introducing Costa Rica

Famed for its eco-credentials and its 'Pura Vida' lifestyle, Costa Rica is as laidback as they come. With some serious world-beating hotels when it comes to sustainability as well as its mission to preserve the planet, Costa Rica entices visitors with jungle-fringed beaches, adrenaline-fuelled activities and a huge diversity of wildlife from sloths to monkeys and the rare resplendent quetzal. Navigate white-water rapids, zipline through the jungle canopy and trek volcano trails before hitting one of the many beaches. And when it comes to beaches you'll be spoiled for choice between Pacific surf or golden Caribbean sands, laidback luxury ecolodges or boutique resorts. Costa Rica is a great option for families, honeymooners, solo travellers and first-timers to Latin America.

How to Get to Costa Rica

Though you can travel overland from Nicaragua and Panama, most will arrive by air into San Jose or Liberia's international airport.

Fly directly from London and the US (4-11 hours).

From San Jose you can take hopper flights to the Osa Peninsula and Guanacaste or travel overland.

When & Weather – Costa Rica

The climate on the coast and lowlands is tropical, which means temperatures are similar year round with April being the hottest month. Temperatures are cooler in the highland cloud-forests and Central Valley.

Peak Season is November to April, the Green season is May to October. But given that temperatures are similar, come in the Green Season when tourists are few. Temperatures typically range from 21C (70F) to 26 (80F) in the Central Highlands, and increase in the coastal lowland regions.

Who will Costa Rica Appeal To?

The stunning natural landscapes offer an enormous range of varied experiences. In particular, it's suited to Families - Active travellers - Wildlife enthusiasts - Adventure-loving honeymooners - Keen photographers - Solo travellers.

Accommodation

Costa Rica excels in beautiful places to stay. Choose from boutique hotels, romantic hideaways, eco-cabanas, coffee plantation farms, jungle lodges, rustic wildlife refuges and exclusive retreats.

Off The Beaten Path

Ride horses in the interior of Guanacaste which is famed for its ranches, wetlands and volcanoes.

Cahuita National Park is one of the world's last living reefs; a haven for snorkelling and diving.

Swap busy Manuel Antonio National Park for the remote Corcovado National Park, home to jaguars, yellow poison-dart frogs, anteaters and ocelots.

Wildlife

Flocks of birds migrate here between September and November — Cabo Matapalo is a major corridor for hummingbirds, toucans and scarlet macaws.

Leatherback turtles nest on the Caribbean Coast from February to April; green turtles during August and September.

Kayak amongst dolphins and humpback whales in the Golfo Dulce.

Watch sloths in the wild, lazily climbing trees or just hanging upside down, asleep.

Giving back

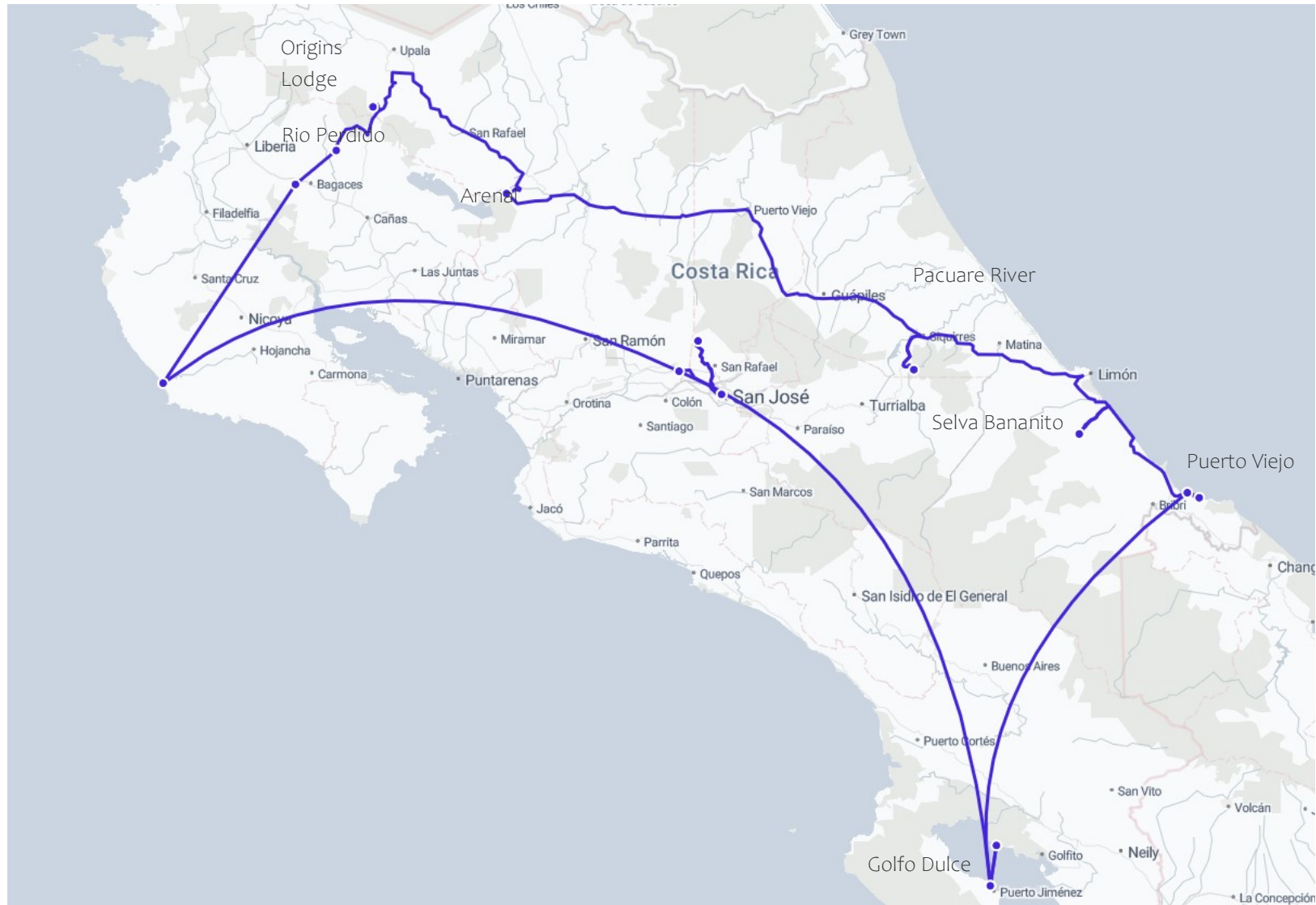
